The Brain Injury Alliance of Colorado (BIAC) is the go-to resource for help and services for survivors of an injury to the brain, their family members, and professionals.

We are the organization that survivors and families can turn to, with trusted staff who will listen, understand their situation, and provide them with solutions to help navigate their path to recovery. We know that suffering an injury to the brain can leave survivors and their families feeling overwhelmed, helpless and lost. Our creative and collaborative services give them support, guidance, and hope.

BIAC provides free statewide case management for children, youth, and adults who have sustained a brain injury

BIAC's approach to case management services is one in which we are allies for our clients. Our staff are the knowledgeable, organized, positive, and professionally-connected supporters that not every survivor has as a resource in their life. We are collaborators and creative problem-solvers, helping to find resources survivors need to become their own self-advocates.

What services are offered?

- A team approach - clients may have access to multiple staff members working with them to achieve their case management goals
- A local presence - case management staff live and work statewide and are available to meet with clients in their communities
- A proactive mindset - case managers contact their clients at regular intervals to check in on them
- Examples of case management activities:
 - Help with filling out applications
 - Connecting individuals to support resources
 - Helping survivors to understand their injury
 - Navigating complex systems of care
 - Providing emotional encouragement and support
- Brain injury educational materials
- Free classes and workshops
- For youth still in the school system, we have a specialist on staff who provides support and consultation about school-related issues

Who is eligible?

- Any resident of Colorado with a medically documented brain injury (If needed BIAC can assist in obtaining documentation)
- Age, time since injury, insurance, or income do not have an impact on eligibility
